Aqua Pennsylvania to Close Route 252 (Leopard Road) Weekdays in Tredyffrin and Easttown Townships

King of Prussia – Aqua Pennsylvania will close and detour Route 252 (Leopard Road) between Route 30 (Lancaster Avenue) and Sugartown Road in Tredyffrin and Easttown townships, Chester County weekdays beginning Monday, Oct. 17 for water main installation, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) today announced. Route 252 (Leopard Road) will be closed and detoured Mondays through Fridays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. until Dec. 15.

During construction, Route 252 (Leopard Road) will be detoured over Darby Road and Route 30 (Lancaster Avenue). Local access will be maintained up the construction zone. Motorists are advised to allow extra time when traveling through the area.

Aqua Pennsylvania will complete the work under a PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permit.

PennDOT reminds motorists they can log on to 511pa.com or call 511 from any phone to check traffic conditions on major highways before heading out.
