Regular Meeting
Tuesday March 16, 2021 (7 PM)
Meeting Minutes

The Meeting was held via an Authorized telecommunication device (GoToMeeting). Present – Margy DePiano (Vice Chair), Ted Babiy, Joan Stillwell, Tom Toscani (Chair), Lisa Schwarcz, Mike Wacey (Supervisor), and Don Curley (Public Works Director).

1. Call to Order – The Chair called the meeting to order at 7 PM.
2. Meeting Minutes
 - a. Consideration of Meeting Minutes from January 21, 2021 Meeting – The PRB approved the minutes by unanimous consent (Public Comment was requested - no one from the public commented).
3. Business and Discussion Items
 - a. Volley Ball Courts at Johnson Park – The PRB reviewed the proposal from the Conestoga High School Volley Ball Coach to restore the sand volley ball courts at the park. Joan Stillwell made a motion to recommend to the Board of Supervisors (BOS) that the Township proceed with the restoration. Mary DiPiano seconded the motion. The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The Chair called the vote. The motion passed unanimously.
 - b. Exercise Equipment at Hilltop Park – The PRB reviewed the prospective installation of exercise equipment along the path. Tom Toscani made a motion to recommend to the BOS that the Township proceed with installation of a push up station, a chin up station, a sit up station, a vertical climb station, and a balance beam station along the walking path at the park (PRB Members would make site visits to the park to identify the best locations). Ted Babiy second the motion. The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The Chair called the vote. The motion passed unanimously.
 - c. July 4th Event – The PRB discussed the prospect of holding the 4th of July picnic. It was agreed by unanimous consent to recommend to the BOS that the Township proceed with the planning phases of the event (it was recognized that COVID circumstances may change such that the event may be cancelled).
4. Old Business – The PRB discussed the following items:
 - Hilltop Garden Restoration – Ted Babiy updated the PRB on the progress.
 - The Basketball Court at Johnson Park – Eric Ostien updated his proposal (as part of a Boy Scouts of America Eagle Scout project) to install baskets for toddler-age children on the

handball courts at the park. The PRB discussed the proposal. Tom Toscani made a motion to recommend to the BOS that the Township proceed with the installation of the baskets. Ted Babi seconded the motion. The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The Chair called the vote. The motion passed unanimously.


- Interface with Environmental Advisory Commission (EAC) – The PRB discussed prospective interface with the EAC.
